If you're an adult experiencing homelessness, Allegheny County's winter shelter plan starts November 15, 2024.



Starting November 15, single shelters will have overflow spaces available. Find the full list of shelters listed on the back, by scanning the QR code below or visit acdhs.org/shelter.

By December 11, Winter Shelter will be open at the Community Resource Center on Maple Avenue. Go to Second Avenue Commons (2AC) for transportation to Winter Shelter.

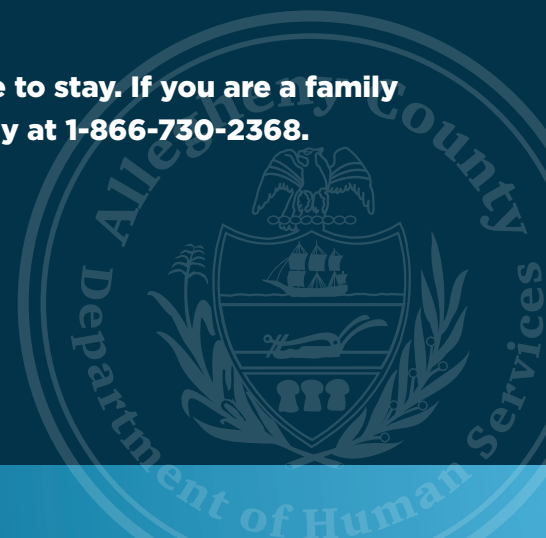
