Northside Partnership Project is available for winter shelter for adults experiencing homelessness.

This winter shelter is located at 2610 Maple Avenue, Pittsburgh PA 15214. Transportation to the Northside Partnership Project is provided daily from 7-10 PM by shuttle from Second Avenue Commons (2AC), located at 700 Second Avenue, Pittsburgh PA, 15219. Return transportation by shuttle is provided each morning from Northside Partnership Project to Second Avenue Commons between 6:30-8:30 AM.



Shelter services:

- Dinner
- Grab and go breakfast
- Congregate sleeping arrangements
- Winter clothing resources
- Additionally, street medicine, street outreach, Allegheny Link and other partners are on site regularly for additional supports.
