On November 15th, DHS will open a winter shelter located at the Community Resource Mall at 2610 Maple Avenue on the North Side. Free transportation to the Winter Shelter will be available each evening from Second Avenue Commons. Return transportation each morning to Second Avenue Commons will also be available.
